The Estate

Originally built in 1830 as a working farm, Newhall Mains has been in our family's hands for over three generations. Like many of the 'mains' buildings — a Scottish term historically used to refer to the main structures of a farm — across Easter Ross which sadly fell into disrepair over the years, this once-abandoned area of our estate became a rustic, history-steeped setting for us to lovingly restore and refine.

Calling on Highland-based craftsmen to resurrect the 'mains' using traditional materials such as stone, lime render, lead, and slate, the buildings which once housed agricultural workers, machinery, and livestock have been thoughtfully reimagined as a family-run hotel on the Cromarty coast. Our five individually decorated cottages and four double bedroom suites sleep up to 28 guests across 14 bedrooms, and the converted barn now seats up to 35 guests for intimate feasts in the Black Isle.

Soaring ceilings and full-height windows framing views of Ben Wyvis and our livestock-grazed grounds create a relaxed ambience for any event you might have in mind, while our light-flooded spaces are a photographer's dream to capture your special day or products on display. From whisky launches to weddings, 'big' birthdays to brand shoots, and everything in between, our spacious steading, courtyard, and private airfield make an idyllic setting for special occasions.

Accomodation

Our cottages open directly onto a central courtyard (which doubles as a summer croquet lawn), creating a convivial atmosphere while acting as a handy outdoor overspill space for events. The interiors have been handpicked for each cottage to bring the natural beauty of the Scottish Highlands inside, with wood-burning fireplaces, deep soaking tubs, fully-equipped kitchens, and underfloor heating throughout. Our suites are on the cosier side, dressed in natural wool blankets spun from our own sheep.


One Bedroom Cottage: Divine Suite

AIR

Your reservation guarantees private access to our airfield, where light aircraft from our friends at Highland Aviation take to the skies, gliding over the Isle of Skye, Cairngorms, Loch Ness, or the West Coast.

Our vintage Beechcraft Bonanza (nicknamed Bessy) is also waiting in the wings for VIP transfers, arrivals by air, and short scenic flights.

Charter our wildlife-watching RIB for a chance to spot bottlenose dolphins, sea birds, and seals from the water. Less frequent sightings might include the shy harbour porpoise, pilot whale, and basking shark. We can also organise visits to remote beaches only accessible by boat for toes-in-sand picnics and seafood barbecues.
